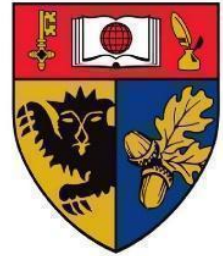

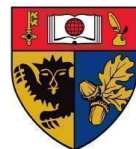


## Year 7
