Students and staff at the Academy are celebrating today as Year 13 pupils secured the best A-level results in the academy's history.

Demonstrating exceptional academic performance across the board, 24% of all A-level entries were awarded top A\*–A grades, while 75% achieved A\*–C grades. The overall average grade for A-level subjects reached a C+, while students taking vocational courses excelled with an incredible Distinction grade average.

The stellar results reflect the hard work of the cohort and the unwavering support of the academy's teaching team. Alongside those taking up places at top Russell Group universities, Year 13 school leavers have successfully secured prestigious apprenticeships and their chosen employment routes.
