### Prevalence of cigarette smoking by sex, 1974 to 2013, Great Britain<sup>23</sup>

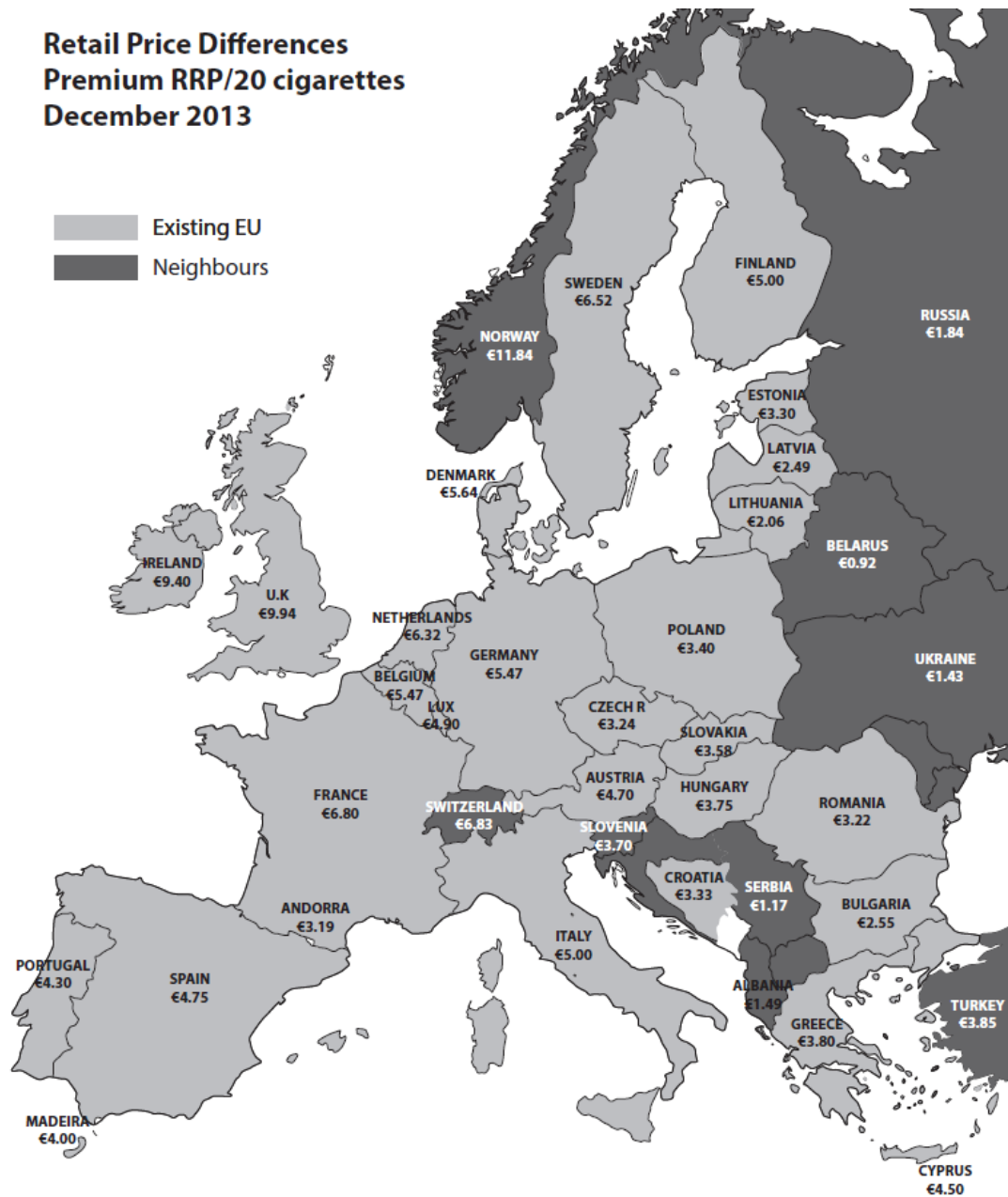

## Appendix 3

'A Health minister said plan packaging of cigarettes was a "proportionate and justified response" because of the health risks associated with smoking.
