How this links to the exam specification	In Level 3 you will be required to complete a short video to show your skills. This project will allow us to see what level you are already on and where you need direct help with your film making.	
How to complete the task:	<p>Make a short film or movie about yourself. This can be in any style from a YouTube style piece to camera or you making a full autobiographic movie about yourself. You don't have to be in the movie but your presence should be felt. Your movie should be between 1 and 2 minutes long.
