Dear Parents & Carers,

We hope that you are all well and looking forward to the return to school next week. We appreciate the hard work that you and your children have put in over the last two and a half months and it is great that we can now see a finish line!

This letter outlines the process for returning and the systems for carrying out the mass-testing for students on their return. There will be a very short phased return to allow for this to happen. Please read the table below carefully.

Over the course of their first week back at school, students will receive three tests and they will return to school the day after their first test, assuming it is negative.

All other students will have lessons set online using the curriculum directory and Google Classroom Year 10, 11 and 13 vocational exams will go ahead as planned.
- Students will not be required to wear school uniform when coming in to receive their **first** test unless they are in Keyworker School.
- Students must wear a mask.
- Students must be in full uniform for their first full day of school.
- If you have not given consent for your child to receive the test they will not receive it. If you have not previously

 line.

I do hope that this will run smoothly and allow us to have our students back in school as quickly and safely as possible.
